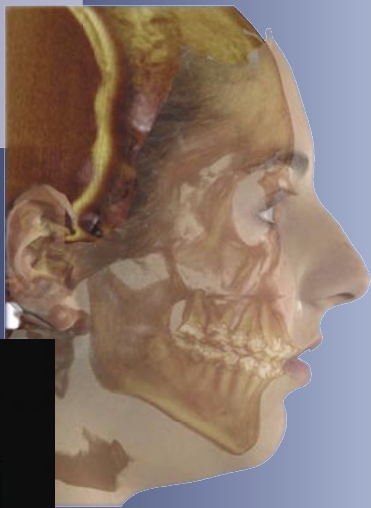

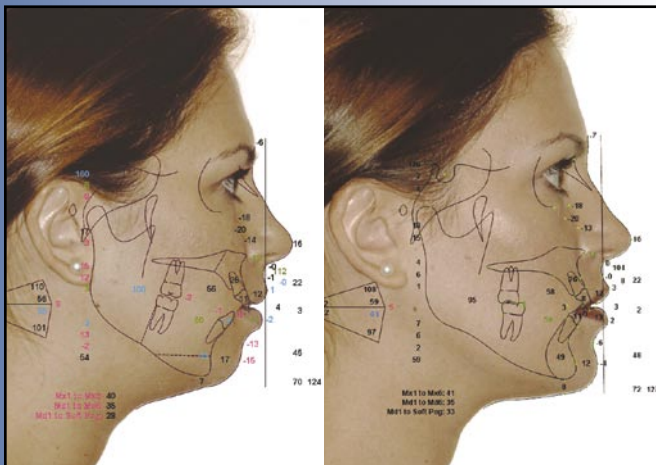

Hands-On Description

The hands-on workshop covers facial analysis, computerized cephalometric treatment planning, and articulator model surgery. A patient from Dr. Arnett's practice is studied. Each



student will complete a facial analysis which will direct cephalometric treatment planning. Indicated cephalometric changes will then be used to guide articulated model surgery. Students' work will be compared to the patient's actual treatment plan and surgery.

Chester Wang and the Dolphin Imaging Team will install a trial version of the "Arnett Module" on all laptops for the cephalometric treatment planning portion of the lecture.

Biographies

G. William Arnett, D.D.S., F.A.C.D.

Dr. Arnett graduated with honors from the University of Southern California Dental School in 1972 and completed his oral and maxillofacial surgery residency at the University of California at Los Angeles. He practiced comprehensive oral surgery until 1985 when he limited his practice strictly to facial reconstruction.



As a lecturer and clinical instructor, Dr. Arnett trains both orthodontic and surgical residents. He is currently on staff as Assistant Professor, Dept. of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery Loma Linda, Clinical Assistant Professor, University of Southern California, Los Angeles, California, Senior Lecturer, Section of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, University of California, Los Angeles, California, Clinical Professor, Dept. of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery The University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio, San Antonio, Texas and Visiting Professor, Universidad del Desarrollo, School of Dentistry, Faculty of Medicine, Santiago, Chile. Dr. Arnett is a Diplomate of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery and has been honored as a Fellow of the American College of Dentists.

Recognized for his national and international lectures and articles, Dr. Arnett is considered to be pre-eminent in the field of orthognathic surgery. His two-part paper, Facial Keys to Orthodontic Diagnosis and Treatment Planning, received the prestigious B.F. and Helen E. Dewel Clinical Orthodontic Award for paper of the year by the American Association of Orthodontists. Last year he co-authored a book with Dr. Richard McLaughlin titled *Facial and Dental Planning for Orthodontists and Oral Surgeons*.

Michael J. Gunson D.D.S., M.D.

Dr. Michael J. Gunson graduated from the University of California at Los Angeles Dental School and continued on to receive his Medical Degree and Specialty Certificate in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery from U.C.L.A. Upon completion of his training, Dr. Gunson was invited to partner with Dr. G. William Arnett at The Center for Corrective Jaw



Surgery in Santa Barbara, California. Since that time, his practice has been solely limited to orthognathic surgery.

Dr. Gunson has lectured and published research on the surgical correction of sleep apnea, the medical treatment of mandibular condylar resorption and the quantification of beauty.
